Kirsten Aspin has been working with children with Autism using the principles of Applied Behaviour Analysis for 8 years. Mrs Aspin holds a Bachelor of Arts (Honours) degree with a major in Psychology and is currently undertaking a Masters in Applied Behaviour Analysis. In 2006 Autism Partnership asked her to open an office in Queensland and since then she has been working with families supervising home programs, consulting in schools and running numerous training workshops. She has spent six years working in the United Kingdom at a school, which adopts the philosophy of ABA. Her role within this school was Program Consultant, which involved supervision and training of staff, direct intervention with children with autism, curriculum development, presentations to other professionals and school management. Through this position Mrs Aspin has had opportunity to complete an eight month internship at Autism Partnership in California and returns to the U.S. once a year for updated training.
